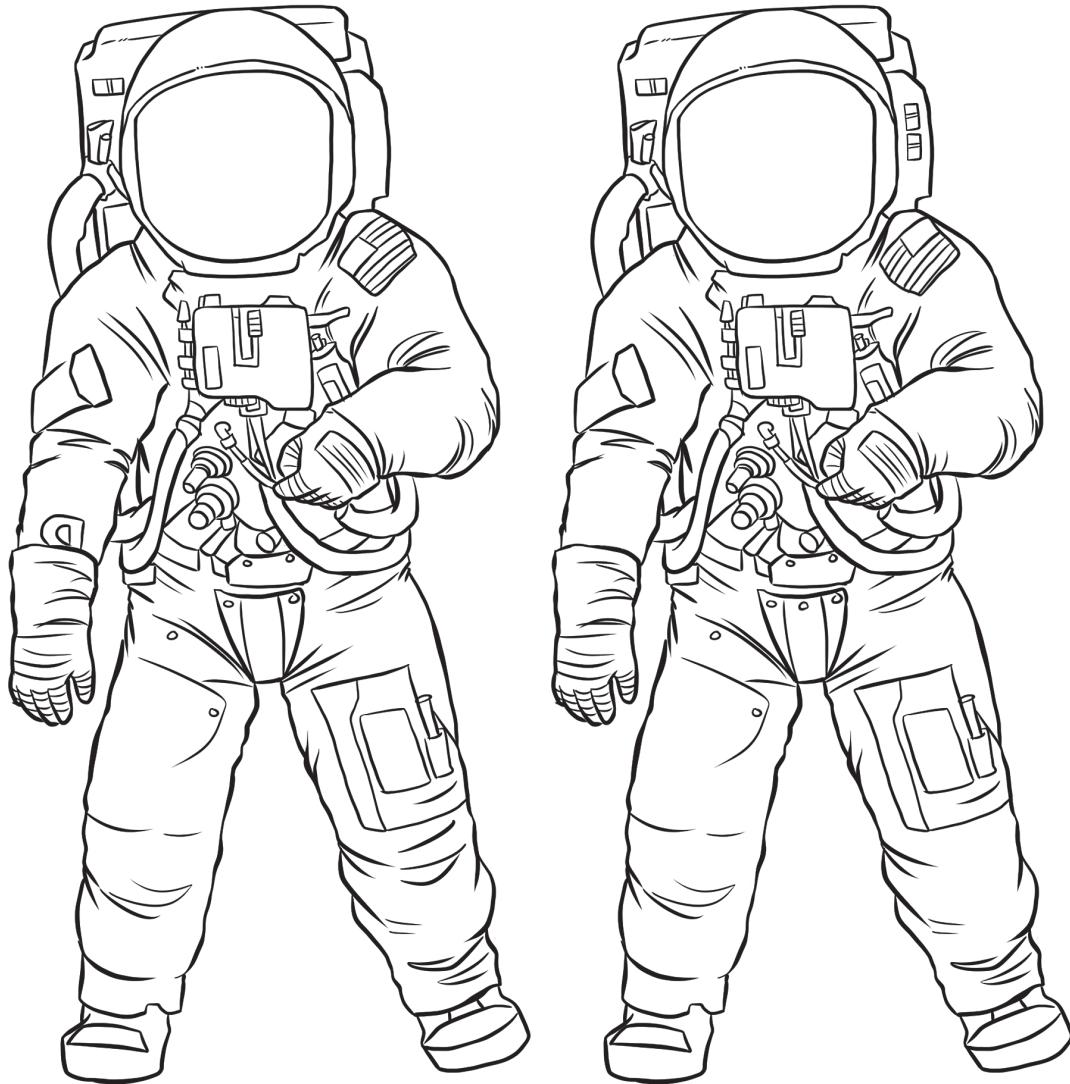


Astronauts
