Acclaimed author and photographer Dudley Edmondson has interviewed 25 Black and Brown scientists, environmental justice activists, and social justice activists to inspire change on a global scale.

*People the Planet Needs Now* is a compilation of personal stories and perspectives from across the United States, as scientists and activists talk about the work they do and their life experiences. The 25 viewpoints are shared conversationally, as if the reader is having a one-on-one dialogue with each storyteller. You'll learn deeply personal details about their childhood, physical- and mental-health struggles, and racist encounters—which influence everything, and what is considered knowledge to where one might live in a particular city and even one's quality of healthcare and education.

These interviews spark conversations about innovative ways to address social, environmental, and related issues.
