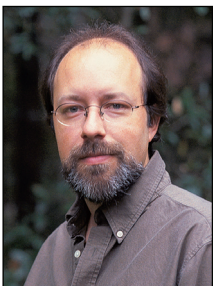
Pollinators & Native Plants for Kids

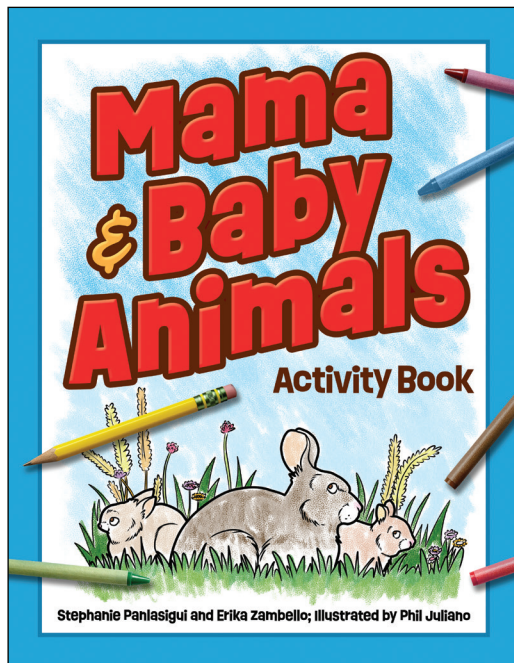


JARET C. DANIELS
